CURB PAINTING APPLICATION FORM

The City of Wauwatosa has created a policy to establish a consistent and standardized process to allow for the painting of roadway curbs adjacent to driveway approaches at the property owner's expense. Curb painting is done to help reduce the likelihood that a vehicle will park within the established no parking zone adjacent to driveways. Current City ordinance requires that no vehicle park within four feet of the entrance to an alley or a private road or driveway.

CURB PAINTING POLICY

I PURPOSE

To establish a consistent and standardized process to evaluate and process requests for curb painting adjacent to drive approaches.

II STATEMENT OF POLICY

The City of Wauwatosa's Transportation Affairs Committee deems it important to provide an optional curb painting program that will allow for painting of curbs adjacent driveways in order to reduce the likelihood that a vehicle will park within the established no parking zone adjacent to driveways.

III POLICY

Requests for curb painting will be processed using the following guidelines:

1. Requests may be made by residents or businesses and must include a property owner's signature.
2. Section 11.32.030(E) of the City's municipal code requires that no vehicle park within four feet of the entrance to an alley or a private road or driveway. Accordingly, curbs will be painted on both sides of a drive approach for a distance of four feet from the location that the drive approach meets the street's full height curb (see example below).
3. Both the vertical face and top of the curb will be power washed and painted with yellow epoxy paint.
4. Applications received prior to April 30th are guaranteed that painting will occur the year the application is received. Applications received after April 30th are not guaranteed installation the same year, however, every attempt will be made to do so. If painting is not able to be completed in the same year the application is received, it will occur the following year.
5. The program fee includes one paint application only. Should the paint fade, wear, or chip away and you wish to have the curb painted again, a new application and fee must be submitted.
6. Property owners are not allowed to self-perform paint application to any public infrastructure including curbs.
7. Should the applicant or future property owner wish to remove the paint it shall be at their expense.
